RE: Approval of the Regenerated Certification Tests and Passing Scores

The Regents Regulations Governing the Certification of Educators in Rhode Island requires RIDE to seek Council approval to adopt new or regenerated certification tests and passing scores that are required for initial licensure.

Educational Testing Service (ETS) provides most Rhode Island Licensure tests and has regenerated four additional tests (Education of Young Children 5024, Elementary Education: Reading Language Arts Subtest 5002, Elementary Education: Mathematics Subtest 5003 and Family Consumer Science 5122).

Rhode Island Educators participated in the multi-state validation studies for the regenerated tests to establish passing scores. As ETS continues to regenerate new tests, a review will occur and the R.I. Department of Education will work with the Council on Elementary and Secondary Education to approve them.

Rhode Island will begin implementing these regenerated tests in August 2015.

Elementary Education: Mathematics Subtest (5003)	157
Family Consumer Science (5122)	153

RECOMMENDATION: THAT, the Council on Elementary and Secondary Education approves the regenerated tests with the recommended cut-scores.
