
11th Grade Math NECAP Results



40% of Rhode Island 11th graders scored a "1," Substantially Below Proficient.




Students with IEPs




83% of students with IEPs received a "1" on the Math NECAP.

Minority Students




61% of minority students received a "1" on the Math NECAP.

Economically Disadvantaged Students




58% of economically disadvantaged students received a "1" on the Math NECAP.

Students with IEPs




29% of students with IEPs received a "1" on the Reading NECAP.
